

# The St. Augustine Years

## THE SECOND ANNUAL MEETING OF THE MARJORIE KINNAN RAWLINGS SOCIETY

In 1940, Marjorie Kinnan Rawlings and her husband, Norton Baskin, moved from Cross Creek to St. Augustine. The move marked the beginning of an exciting time in the life of the author, a time that will be remembered and celebrated when The Marjorie Kinnan Rawlings Society holds its Second Annual Meeting in St. Augustine this April.

The location is fitting on this 50th anniversary of the awarding of the Pulitzer Prize to Rawlings for her novel, *The Yearling*. With money she made from that book, she bought a cottage at Crescent Beach, near St. Augustine, and later helped her husband, Norton Baskin, purchase the Castle Warden Hotel, now Ripley's Museum. She died at Flagler Hospital in St. Augustine in December, 1953.

The sites of the Society's weekend of activities takes in some of St. Augustine's most beautiful landmarks, all of which were very familiar to Rawlings. The weekend will begin with a reception in the courtyard of the magnificent Lightner Museum, formerly the Hotel Alcazar, this year celebrating its centennial. The evening will continue with a memorable presentation by Cross Creek residents, Idella Parker and Jake Glisson.

Friday morning will begin the weekend's full program of presentations on the life and works of Rawlings. After lunch in one of St. Augustine's numerous restaurants, the afternoon will continue with presentations and conclude with a tour of Castle Warden, the former hotel-home of Marjorie and Norton. Friday evening will feature a Cross Creek Cookery buffet at Marineland and a delightful presentation by Marian Conner, "Memoirs of Cross Creek."

Saturday morning, the program presentations will conclude, and be followed by a picnic lunch at the historic Llambias House and a literary tour of St. Augustine by David Nolan, noted author of *Fifty Feet in Paradise*. The weekend will conclude on Saturday evening with a reception at Markland, a 19th century mansion in the city, and dinner in the magnificent dining room of Flagler College, formerly the Ponce de Leon Hotel.
